

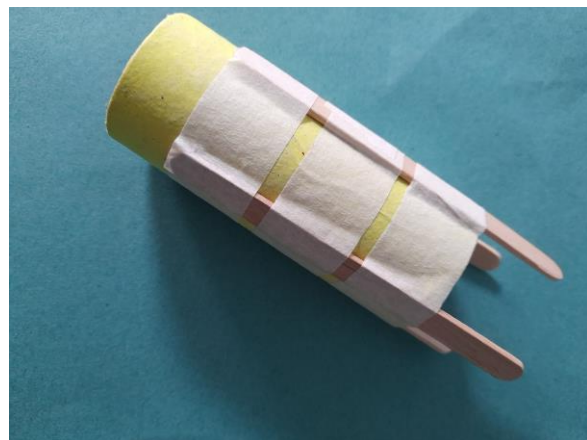
## French Knitting



### **You will need:**

Cardboard tube (loo roll)  
Wool  
4 x lolly sticks  
Tape  
Scissors

### **Making the knitting Dolly**



Tape 4 lolly sticks around the outside of the cardboard tube leaving 2 cm sticking out over the end, Ensure the lolly sticks are evenly spaced around the tube. Secure with 2 more rows of tape.

# Make and Take @ Home

1. Start off by tying the wool around one of the lolly sticks leaving a long tail to pass through the centre of the cardboard tube
2. Moving to the stick on the right, wrap the wool twice around this stick in a clockwise direction from back to front
3. Using your fingers or a blunt needle, lift the lower loop over the upper loop and off the top of the stick leaving just one loop on the stick
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 on the next 2 sticks until you are left with one loop on each of the 4 sticks.
5. It should look like this .



# Make and Take @ Home

6. Continue knitting by wrapping the wool once around the stick to the right above the loop that is already there. Lift the bottom loop up over the top loop and off the lolly stick.



7. Give the tail an occasional gentle tug to guide it through the centre of the cardboard tube.



8. Repeat step 6 moving around the 4 pegs on the dolly from left to right until the knitting appears through the end of the tube and is the length you require.



# Make and Take @ Home

9. To cast off lift one single loop from one peg and transfer it to the lolly stick to the right
10. Repeat step 9 until you have just one loop on one of the lolly sticks
11. Slip the last loop off the lolly stick and cut your wool leaving a long tail.
12. Secure the end by passing the tail through the loop and tying a knot.
