

Hoopla Game

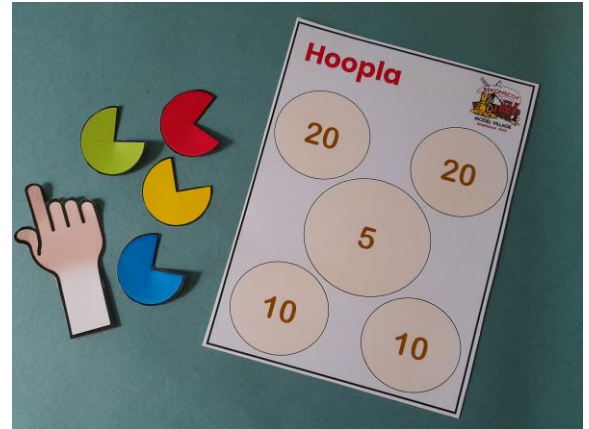


You will need:

- Templates printed out onto card or stuck to an old cereal box
- Scissors
- Glue
- Lolly stick

Make and Take @ Home

1. Cut out the game board, hands and cones from the printed templates

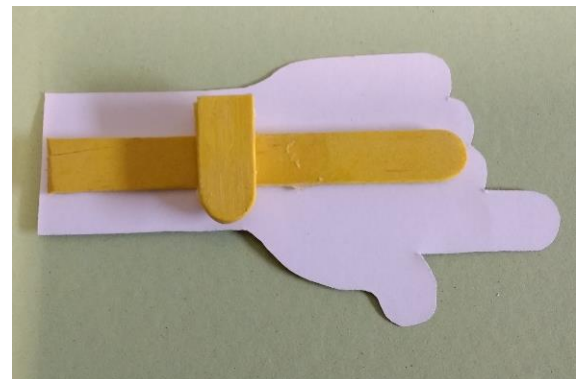


2. Apply glue to the edge of each cone template, wrap it around to form a cone shape and stick down.
Repeat with the 4 different coloured cones



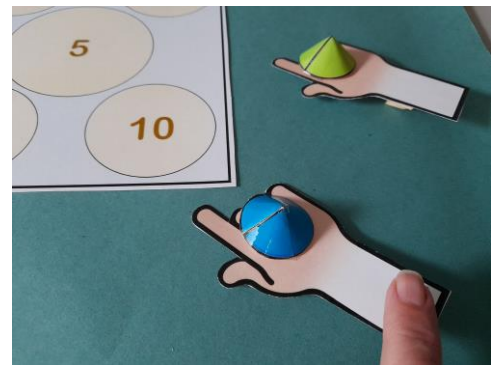
3. Cut your lolly stick in half. Keep one half and cut the smaller half into 4 pieces.

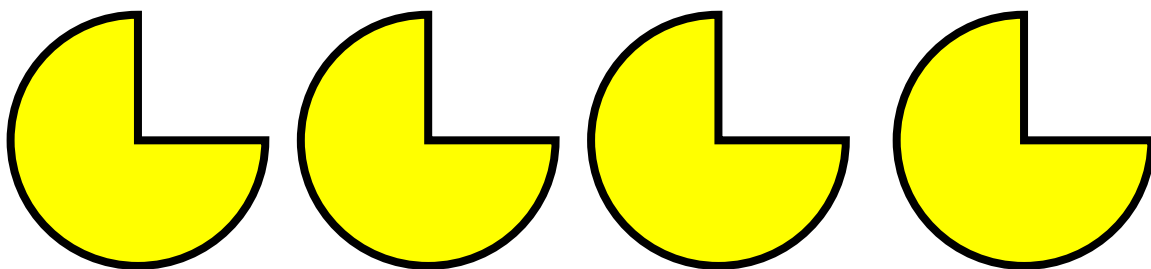
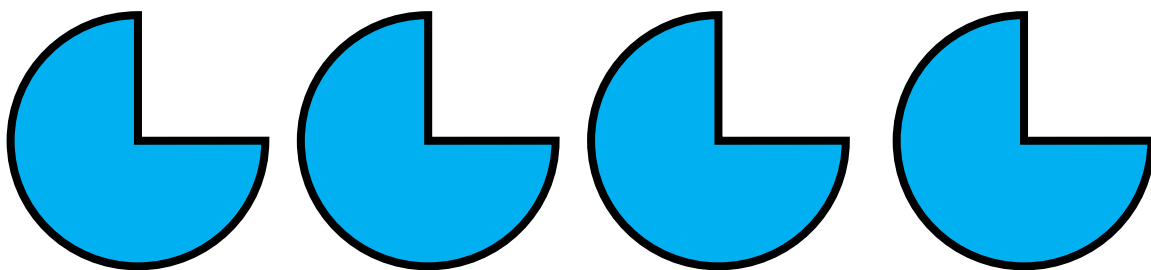
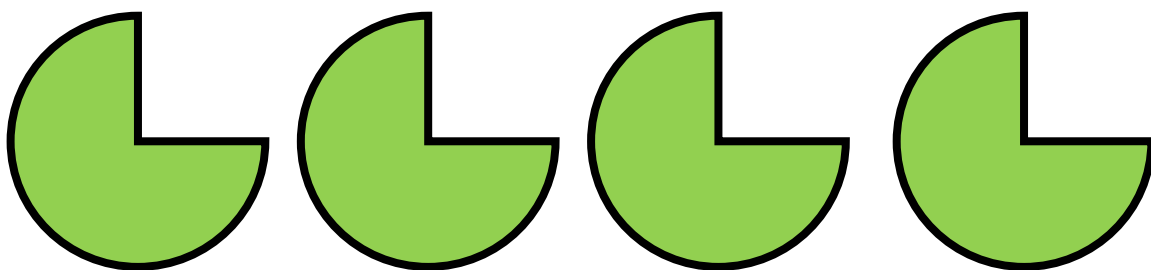
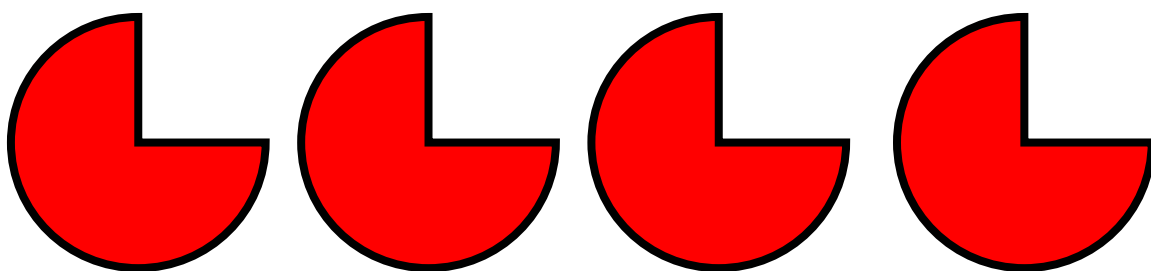
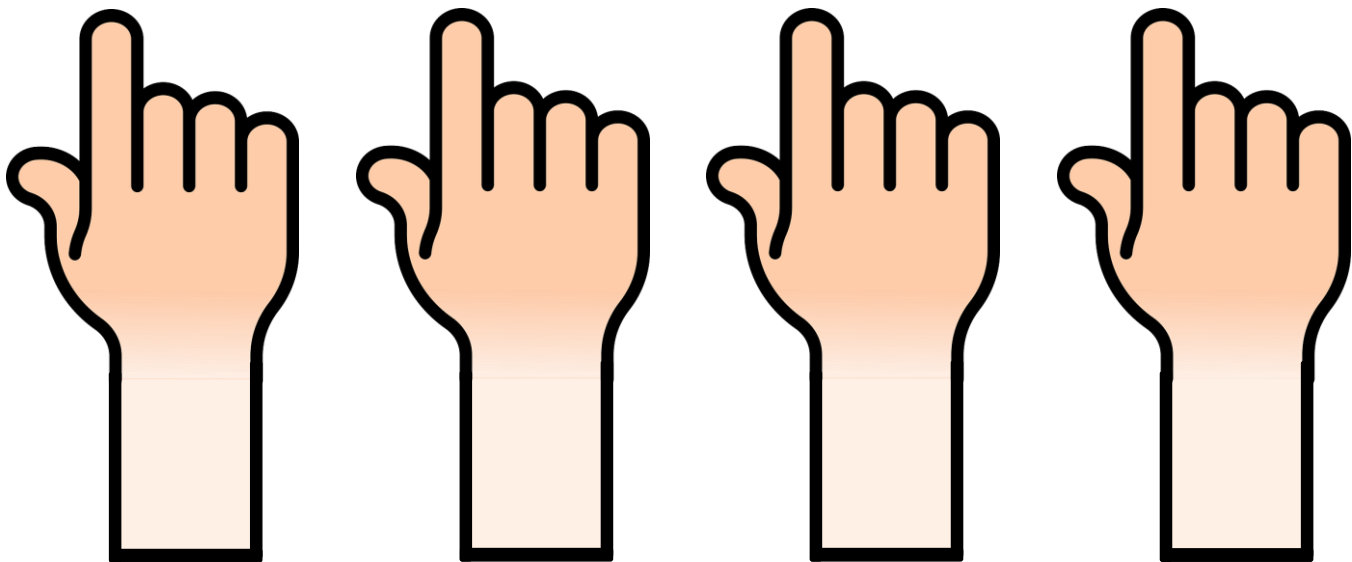
4. Stick the long piece of lolly stick and a stack of smaller pieces to the back of the hand template as shown to create a see-saw launcher



Make and Take @ Home

1. To play, each player has a set of the same coloured cones and a hand launcher
2. Place the launchers around the game board with the finger end tipped towards the table
3. Place a cone onto the finger end of the launcher and hit the other end with your hand launching the cone towards the game board
4. Players take it in turns to launch their cones and score points by landing their cones in the score zones
5. Once all players have launched their 4 cones, the player with the most points wins
